## Step 1 — Removing protector cap



• Using the appropriate tool, unscrew to protector cap.

## Step 2 — Removing reservoir cap



- <u>**\*WARNING\***</u> Reservoir contain high gas pressure. Be sure the pressure is released before removing the cap.
- Push de internal valve to remove nitrogen pressure.
- Remove retaining ring and pull the cap out with the appropriate tool.



### Step 3 — Installing new cap



- Apply some grease on the o-ring and push the cap Inside the reservoir.
- Re-install the retaining ring , and make sure it is sit in is groove

### Step 4 — Charging reservoir



- Charge the reservoir at 200 psi of nitrogen.
- Install the protective cap.
