

Step 1 — STAGE 1 SHOCK INSTALLATION



- FRONT SHOCKS: SCHRAEDER
 VALVE AT THE TOP AND
 TOWARDS OUTSIDE OF THE
 VEHICLE.
- ⚠ IMPORTANT NOTE: LEFT AND RIGHT REAR SHOCKS ARE IDENTICAL
- IMPORTANT NOTE: The schraeder valve on the shocks is not an adjustment! Shocks are charged with nitrogen during assembly. Only a qualified mechanic with proper tools and qualifications can re-charge the shocks after servicing. Messing with the valve can release nitrogen pressure and prevent the shocks from working properly.

Step 2 — STAGE 1 SHOCK INSTALLATION



- REAR SHOCKS: SCHRAEDER VALVE AT THE TOP AND TOWARDS OUTSIDE OF THE VEHICLE.
